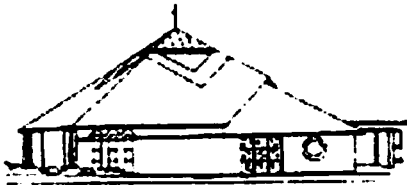

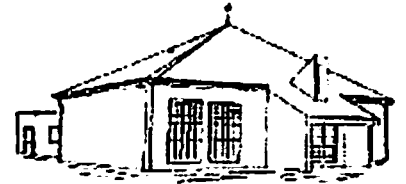

Ash Wednesday & Lent

This week is the beginning of Lent. Parishioners are requested to try to observe this gracious season with total self giving. The season of Lent is a period of preparation for the celebration of Easter. The Liturgy prepares the catechumens for the celebration of the Paschal mystery by the various stages of Christian initiation. It also prepares the faithful who recall their baptism and do penance in preparation for Easter. This period,

up to Easter, is the most important in the Church's liturgical calendar. All our parishioners are invited to attend the liturgies and devotions and to observe the three fold themes of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Those aged sixty and above, nursing mothers, children and those who have some health issues are not required to fast.

There are opportunities for confession in all our churches. You could also ring 01494-438300 to book an appointment to see a Priest for confession if you can not make the official confession times.
