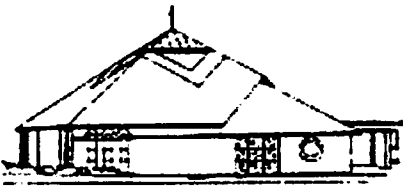

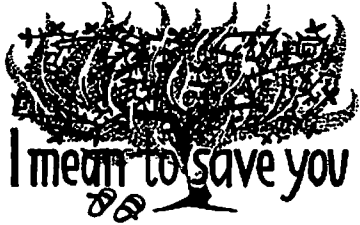

For as the heavens are high above the earth so strong is his love for those who fear him. (R)

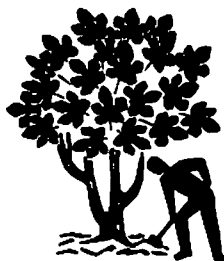
GOSPEL ACCLAMATION
