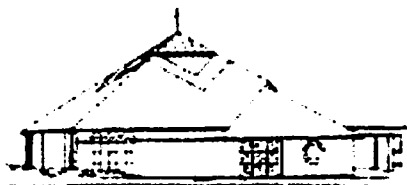

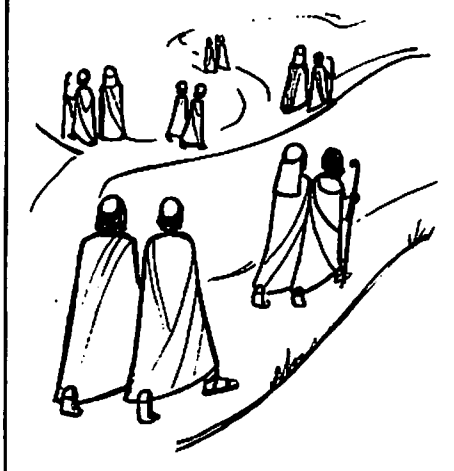

The End of an Era and a New Beginning

On Thursday the St Thomas More Deanery Pastoral Council held its last meeting as the deaneries have now been disbanded as part of Bishop Peter's new plans for the diocese. We are now in the smaller grouping of churches called the South Bucks Pastoral Area (comprising the Catholic Churches of Wycombe, Marlow, Bourne End and Beaconsfield) - see the poster in the porch. The plan is that this smaller grouping will allow more co-operation between the parishes than a deanery could provide. Our dean is Fr. Francis Higgins of St Teresa's, Beaconsfield, and he will soon be choosing a "Pastoral Area Link" and a steering group to help produce a 5 year plan for the pastoral area.
