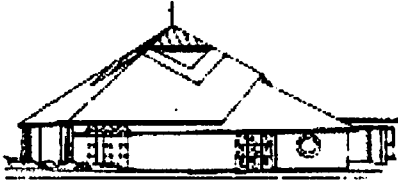

R. From all my terrors the Lord set me free.

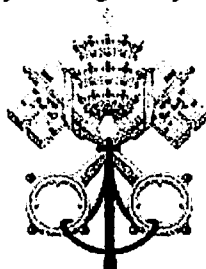
1. I will bless the Lord at all times, his praise always on my lips; in the Lord my soul shall make its boast. The humble shall hear and be glad. (R)

The Year for Priests

Benedict XVI opened The Year for Priests on June 19th. The theme for the priestly year is "Faithfulness of Christ, Faithfulness of Priests." The year coincides with the 150th anniversary of the death of St. Jean Marie Vianney, the Curé of Ars, "Dear Lord and Friend of priests, send daily to all priests the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit, that they may become all things to all men, in life and in death. Give them patience with the little ones, compassion for the sick, humility with the poor, courage before the enemies of the Church. Make them tireless in teaching, patient and kind in the confessional, generous in the administration of Holy Communion. Let them be messengers of peace to all men of good will. Wherever they go, may Your blessing go with them; wherever they abide, may Your peace enter in. Whoever they bless, may he or she also be blessed by You. Make them apostles, make them saints. Most blessed Virgin Mary, pray for our priests and inspire them with love for your Son. St. John Vianney pray for us and for all our priests."
